



CAUTION: This applicator should only be used in a press with a shut height of 135.80 mm (5.346"). Tooling damage could result at a lower setting.

CAUTION: To prevent injury never operate this Applicator without the guards supplied with the press or wire-processing machine in place. Reference the press or wire processing manufacturer's instruction manual.
