

# 74HC3G34-Q100; 74HCT3G34-Q100

Dual non-inverting Schmitt trigger

Product data sheet

## 1. General description

The 74HC3G34-Q100; 74HCT3G34-Q100 are triple buffers. Inputs include clamp diodes. This enables the use of current limiting resistors to interface inputs to voltages in excess of V<sub>cc</sub>.

This product has been qualified to the Automotive Electronics Council (AEC) standard Q100 (Grade 1) and is suitable for use in automotive applications.

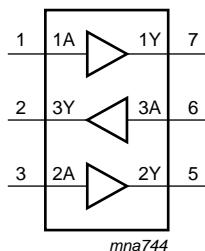


Fig 1. Logic symbol

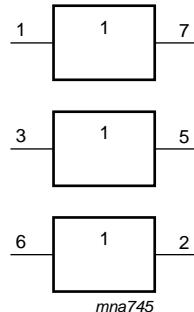


Fig 2. IEC logic symbol

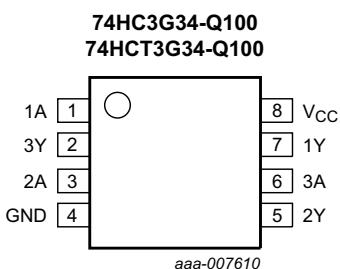


Fig 3. Pin configuration SOT505-2 (TSSOP8) and SOT765-1 (VSSOP8)

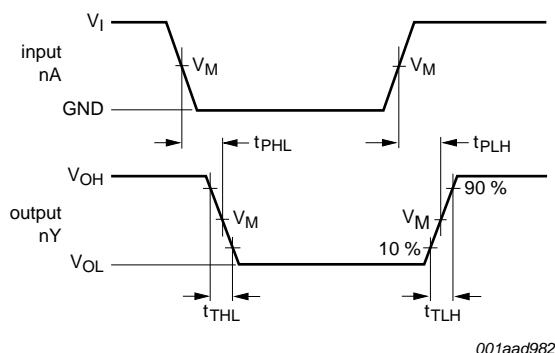

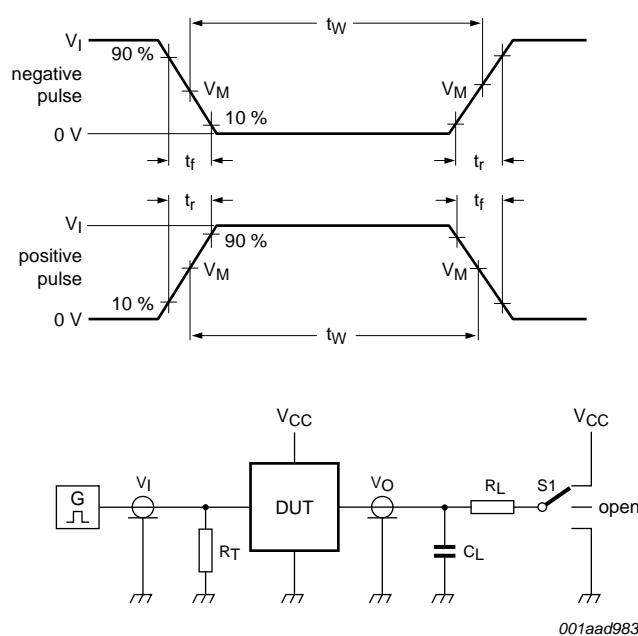

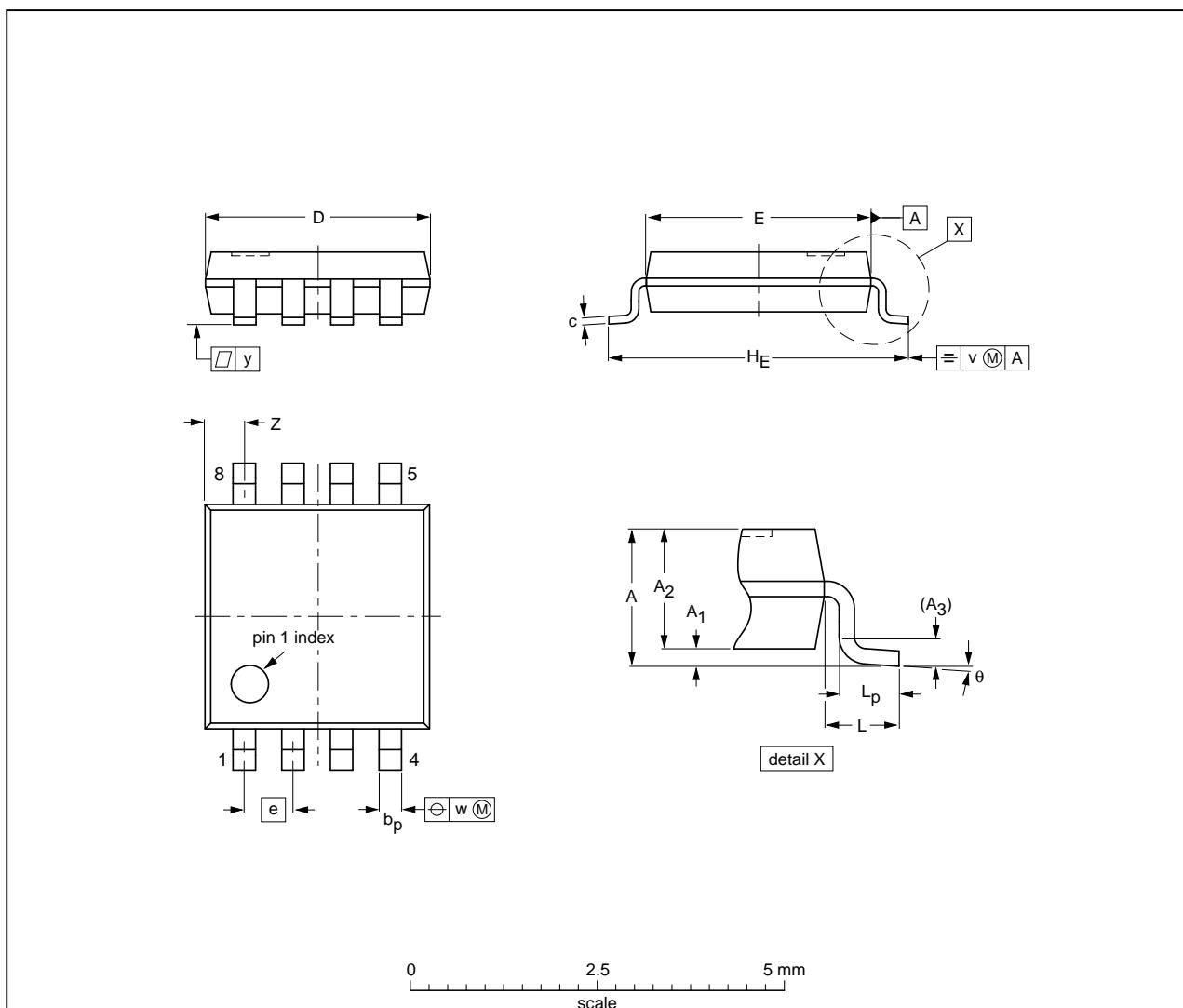
**Fig 5. Test circuit for measuring switching times**

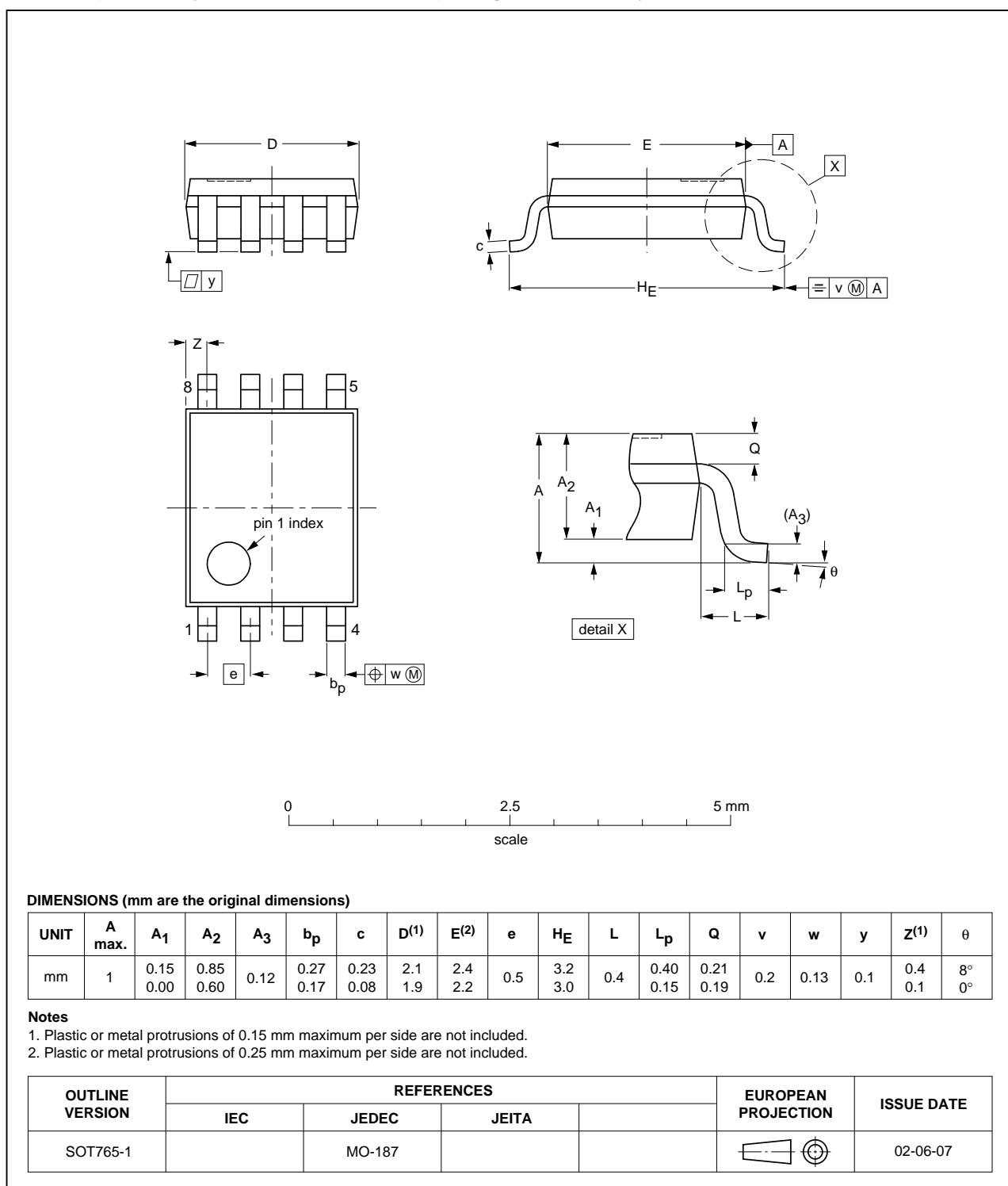


Fig 7. Package outline SOT765-1 (VSSOP8)
