
GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The 86004I is a high performance 1:4 LVCMOS/LVTTL Clock Buffer. The 86004I has a fully integrated PLL and can be configured as zero delay buffer and has an input and output frequency range of 15.625MHz to 62.5MHz. The VCO operates at a frequency range of 250MHz to 500MHz. The external feedback allows the device to achieve "zero delay" between the input clock and the output clocks. The PLL SEL pin can be used to bypass the PLL for system test and debug purposes. In bypass mode, the reference clock is routed around the PLL and into the internal output divider.










3.3V CORE/3.3V OUTPUT LOAD ACTEST CIRCUIT


3.3V Core/2.5V OUTPUT LOAD ACTEST CIRCUIT






2.5VCore/ 2.5V OUTPUT LOAD AC TEST CIRCUIT

CYCLE-TO-CYCLE JITTER








OUTPUT SKEW

STATIC PHASE OFFSET





Power Supply Filtering Techniques




FIGURE 1. POWER SUPPLY FILTERING

As in any high speed analog circuitry, the power supply pins are vulnerable to random noise. To achieve optimum jitter performance, power supply isolation is required. The 86004l provides separate power supplies to isolate any high switching noise from the outputs to the internal PLL. $V_{\tiny DD}, V_{\tiny DDA}$ and $V_{\tiny DDO}$ should be individually connected to the power supply plane through vias, and $0.01\mu F$ bypass capacitors should be used for each pin. Figure 1 illustrates this for a generic $V_{\tiny DD}$ pin and also shows that $V_{\tiny DDA}$ requires that an additional10 Ω resistor along with a $10\mu F$ bypass capacitor be connected to the $V_{\tiny DDA}$ pin.

RECOMMENDATIONS FOR UNUSED INPUT AND OUTPUT PINS

INPUTS:

LVCMOS CONTROL PINS

All control pins have internal pullups or pulldowns; additional resistance is not required but can be added for additional protection. A $1k\Omega$ resistor can be used.

OUTPUTS:

LVCMOS OUTPUTS

All unused LVCMOS output can be left floating. We recommend that there is no trace attached.

SCHEMATIC EXAMPLE




FIGURE 2. 860041 SCHEMATIC EXAMPLE

Figure 2 shows a schematic example of using an 86004I. It is recommended to have one decouple capacitor per power pin. Each decoupling capacitor should be located as close as possible to the

power pin. The low pass filter R7, C11 and C16 for clean analog supply should also be located as close to the $V_{\tiny DDA}$ pin as possible.

PACKAGE OUTLINE - G SUFFIX 16 LEAD TSSOP


