
#### logic diagram (positive logic)





Figure 1. Load Circuit and Voltage Waveforms





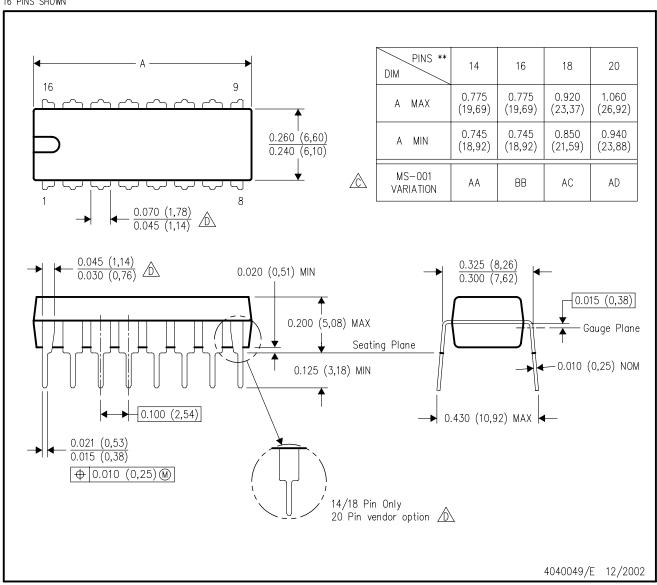

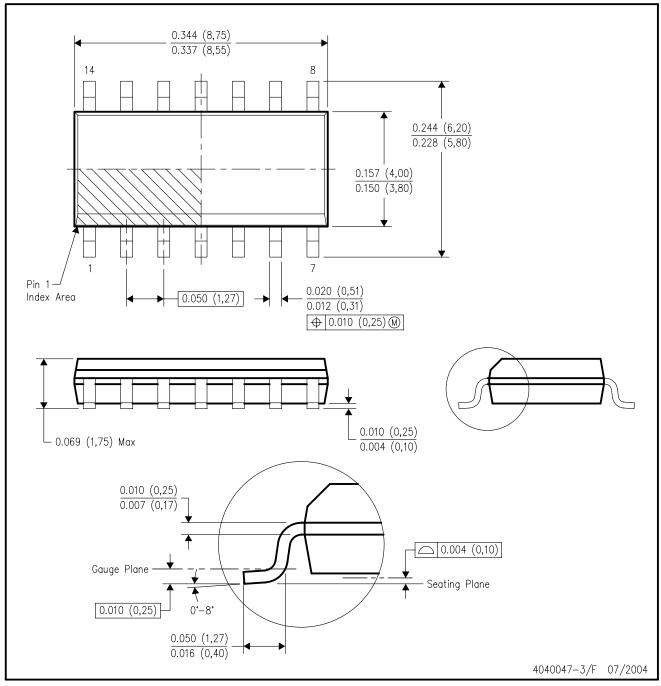
