### 1. General description

Planar passivated high commutation three quadrant triac in a SOT186A (TO-220F) "full pack" plastic package intended for use in circuits where high static and dynamic dV/dt and high dl/dt can occur. This "series CT" triac will commutate the full RMS current at the maximum rated junction temperature ( $T_j = 150$  °C) without the aid of a snubber. it is used where "high junction operating temperature capability" is required.



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
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
